Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers. 1 Timothy 4:16
1. God's gift was perfect because of Jesus'  "But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son,"
Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him." John 3:36
And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are to be pitied more than all men.  1 Corinthians 15:17, 19
The doctrine of the T, teaches us that God is one, manifest (showing Himself) in three persons of equal importance— Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. John 1:1-3
The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the
