8. Describe Hannah's ongoing relationship with Samuel after she gave him to fulltime service at the tabernacle.

9. In what ways was Hannah rewarded for her gift of Samuel to the Lord's service?

Bible Connections

- 1. Read 1 Samuel 1:7 and Numbers 18:24-32. What brought Hannah "year by year" to the house of the LORD?
- 2. Read 1 Samuel 1 :3 and 1 Samuel 2: 13-24. In addition to the bad behavior of the high priest's sons, Hophni and Phineas, the visible manifestation of God's glory that once resided over the ark of the covenant was long gone from the tabernacle. What emotions did Hannah and others in her family likely have as they made their annual trip to the tabernacle at Shiloh?
- 3. Read 1 Samuel 1:4-5. Elkanah gave one portion of offering to Peninnah and all her sons and daughters, and a double portion to Hannah. What emotional difficulties in Elkanah's family might have grown from this discrepancy in "portions" given to his two wives?

What damage is caused by expressions of favoritism in a family?

- 4. Read 1 Samuel 1:18. Also read Psalm 55:22 and 1 Peter 5:6-7. In what ways was Hannah's reply to the high priest Eli an expression of faith?
- 5. Read 1 Samuel 2:1-10. List the key words and phrases in Hannah's prayer.
