for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. Romans 3:23-24

God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished— Romans 3:25

he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus. **Romans 3:26**

We are made alive in Christ Jesus.

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9** 

#### 1. We must put our trust in Christ, not ourselves

We are saved by putting our faith in God's grace, in His love, in the death of Jesus Christ for us on the cross.

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. **Ephesians 2:10** 

#### 2. Do good works for others and not ourselves

#### Why do we do good works for God?

- Motivation—not to earn salvation, but to show our gratitude that we have been saved by Christ
- Purpose—not to be saved, but to exalt Jesus Christ

God has prepared us to do good works, so we can be a testimony to others.

In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven. **Matthew 5:16**
