### 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12

"You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men. **Matthew 5:13** 

Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, with a continual lust for more. **Ephesians 4:19** 

Finally, brothers, we instructed you how to live in order to please God, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this more and more.

## Three specifics in which Paul tells Christians to be distinctive

# 1. One specific Area of Distinctiveness—S\_\_\_\_\_ Purity.

not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God; 1 Thessalonians 4:5

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse. For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools Romans 1:18-22

It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality;

1 Thessalonians 4:3

Therefore, he who rejects this instruction does not reject man but God, who gives you his Holy Spirit. 1 Thessalonians 4:8

that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable, 1 Thessalonians 4:4

## 2. An Attitude of Distinctiveness—C\_\_\_\_\_\_

Three specifics in which Paul tells Christians to be distinctive.

Now about brotherly love we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other. **1 Thessalonians 4:9** 

"If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. John 15:18-19

As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you. **John 15:19** 

**Emotivism** is the view that moral judgments do not function as statements of fact but rather as expressions of the speaker's or writer's feelings.

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. **John 3:19** 

By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:35

But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. Matthew 5:44-45

He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? Matthew 5:45-46

Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. Romans 12:21

3. An Arena of Distinctiveness—the W
Three specifics in which Paul tells Christians to be distinctive.
Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business and to work with your hands, just as we told you, so that your daily life may win the respect of outsiders 1 Thessalonians 4:11-12
